Aim

To recognise a passionate individual who has developed and driven a successful entrepreneurial idea for the food and beverage industry in one (or more) of the following areas:

- Innovation in food products or business
- Export
- New product development
- Sustainability
- Primary production
- Development of people skills/capability

Eligibility

This award is conferred by a panel of industry experts based on industry nominations. Individuals cannot directly apply for this award.

To be eligible for nomination, the individual must living in South Australia and currently working in the South Australian food and beverage sector.

Duncan MacGillivray

This award was introduced in 2014 as a tribute to a great South Australian entrepreneur, the late Duncan MacGillivray. Duncan was an indefatigable ambassador for South Australia and for the foods and beverages produced here. Duncan was the mastermind behind Two Dogs alcoholic lemonade and the driving force for the creation of Kangaroo Island Pure Grain. He championed our state's fruit, beef, grain and beverage products domestically and internationally.
